Year 6 SATs – message to Year 6 Children

Athlete Visit

We were delighted to welcome Jazz Crawford to school last week. She led an inspiring assembly about what can be achieved with hard work and determination. Year 5 then had a fantastic morning with Jazz as she put them through their paces in an athletics workshop. Lots of great stretches, static and dynamic as well as some races at the end!

Jazz will be coming in a few times over the next few months to work with more year groups – watch this space!



ALL ABOUT JAZZ: Jazz won her first national title in 2012 in 200m sprint, setting the record as the fastest 14 year old in the 200m in the UK with a sprint of 24.48s. She also won a silver medal in 2015 at the English Schools Championships and a bronze medal in the 200m England Athletics U20/U23 championships which led to her to be selected for Team GB in 2017. She then competed for Team GB in Manheim, Germany in the 100m and she was also a 4x 100m European Junior Championship bronze medallist. Jazz is aiming to compete at the Olympics in Tokyo in 2020. Jazz is studying Law with Business at Birmingham University as well as competing as a GB international athlete and training 6 days a week!

Before the auditions you need to practise several times.

You must know your act really well and be able to perform it without looking at words etc. You will be allowed music or backing music if you need it. When we have seen all the auditions, we will select some acts to perform at the Talent Show.

We also require two or three Year 5 or 6 children to be the presenters of the show. If you are interested in being a presenter, you will also need to audition. You will be given something to read out so we can check that you are confident with speaking clearly and loudly.

Late Pick-Ups from after school activities

We are having an increasing number of parents who are arriving late to collect their child after an event. Staff are regularly out on trips and sporting fixtures with children until late afternoon / evening on top of already long days in school. For them to then have to wait with children who are not collected on time is unfair on those staff. We know this is a minority of parents but it only takes one from each event to be late for the staff to be delayed.

Please ensure you arrive before the published collection time for after school clubs, sporting fixtures and school trips so that you are ready to meet your child as they arrive back.

Please follow these guidelines if your child is taking part in an activity that finishes after school:

- Arrive at least 5 minutes before the scheduled pick up time
- If using the staff car park park in a marked space and once the children are back walk to collect them from the member of staff

We aim to arrive back as close to the time stated and let parents know where possible if there is going to be a significant change, but often the exact timings of such events and/or traffic means that we may be back earlier or later. Thank you.
